

SCOUTCON 101

Some things to think about!

1. Enjoy yourselves, there will be many games at the event, try some new ones and bring one or more to teach others. Also, play fair!
2. You will get a lunch, but there is a concession if you wish to buy any additional food or snacks like burgers, chips, and candy.
3. Remember to bring your water bottle and store it under the table. Water is the only thing allowed in the gaming area. Wet things and food wreck games. IF you bring snacks, please ensure that they are NUT FREE! There may be someone with a nut allergy that touches a game piece that has come in contact with nuts.
4. Yes, the Con runs from 9:30am – 6:00ish. If you want to enjoy the whole day and love games, stay, and play all day. If you get tired, you do not need to stay the entire time. You will still be entered in the draws for attending and completing different tasks.
5. This is a Scouting event be sure to wear your SCOUT shirt and NECKERS. Leave your permits and your knives at home please.
6. Only Scouts, Vents, Rovers, and Cubs will get the opportunity to play in the Scoutcon tournament. Sorry Scouters, Beavers and non-scouts, this one is not for you.
7. Bathing and deodorant is a must, please make sure that you shower and wear it, so others can enjoy their gaming experience.
8. Typically, there are no electronic video games allowed at this event (with one exception #14 and #17). The idea behind this Con is to be a social event where you can meet other people. Electronics do not allow a lot of interaction with others.
9. This is a gaming event not a Drama production. Please leave your Drama at home!
10. There will be sign-ups for organized play games like Dungeons and Dragons and Star Wars: Age of Rebellion. You will get to sign up for some of these online or when you get there. Please sign-up for one, so that others may have a chance to do the same. If there is room after everyone has had a chance, perhaps you can sign up for a second one at the event. Each of these games takes 1- 2 hours. If your signed-up for one prepare to stay for the whole game and stay focused to respect the other players and the Game Master.
11. There will be many Scouters on site that can help you find a game to participate in. If you want to watch some games, that is a possibility as well.
